Or get closer than you'd ever imagine to humpback whales and brown bears in the wild. Take a cruise from Icy Strait Point and enjoy Alaska's awe-inspiring scenery and the many excursion options that Norwegian Cruise Line has to offer.



Experience unparalleled glacier viewing from such places as Tracy Arm Fjord, the Juneau Icefields and Glacier Bay National Park. Deposit and final payments

- Final payments will be due in my office March 1, 2018.

Cancellation dates, policies and fees per person

- Cancellation penalties increase until the sail date.
\$100 of your deposit goes to the airline and is non-refundable from the time of your initial deposit.
- 90-76 days prior to departure – 25% of Cruise & Land plus \$100 for air.
- 75-61 days prior to departure – 50% of Cruise & Land plus 50% of the air.
- 60-31 days prior to departure – 75% of Cruise & Land plus 75% of the air.
- 30 days or less from departure – no refunds.
